

BEST INTERNATIONAL WEBSERIES AWARD

Call for entries for the webseries competition of the II Edition of the CARBALLO INTERPLAY Digital Content Festival, which will be held from the **16th to the 18th of April** in Carballo (Galicia).

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Webseries submissions are open until March **2, 2015** using the online application form available on the festival website.

Entries should be done through the festival website, filling in the online application form.

Webseries produced between 2013-2015 that have at least three episodes broadcasted at the time of submission are eligible. They could be of any duration, theme, genre, either fiction or animation, national or international.

Webseries produced outside Spain can only compete for the Best International Webseries Award consisting of 800 euros plus trophy.

JUDGING PROCESS

The festival organisers will get in touch with the creator/s of the shortlisted webseries to request the delivery of two episodes in good resolution via Wetransfer, a one minute long video caption and other promotional materials (stills, poster...).

Eligible works must be in the Galician or Spanish language or have Galician or Spanish subtitles.

JURY

The jury will be formed by professionals related to webseries, film and culture and also representatives of related professional associations. Jury members will be announced on this website.

AWARDS

The full list of awards is as follows:

BEST FICTION WEBSERIES // 800 euros plus trophy
BEST ANIMATION WEBSERIES // 800 euros plus trophy
BEST INTERNATIONAL WEBSERIES // 800 euros plus trophy
BEST WEBSERIES IN GALICIAN LANGUAGE // 800 euros plus trophy
AUDIENCE AWARD // 400 euros plus trophy
AGAG AWARD FOR THE BEST SCRIPT // 200 euros plus trophy
BEST ACTRESS // trophy
BEST ACTOR // trophy

Trophys will be original works by artist [David Méndez Alonso](#).

If there is a tie between two webseries, the amount of the prize will be split between the winners.

Awards are subject to taxation according to the Spanish Law.

The creator/s of the winning webseries or a designated representative must attend the awards ceremony that will take place on Saturday April 18. The festival organisers will notify in advance to arrange travel details and will cover accommodation costs of the winner/s.

For the BEST INTERNATIONAL WEBSERIES the organisers understand that attendance can be complicated. In case it is not possible, they will request the winning webseries a video to be screened during the awards ceremony.

COMMUNICATION

The festival reserves the right to use extracts of the shortlisted webseries for its official trailer as well as the utilisation of graphic materials (pictures/stills/poster/etc.) for promotional purposes (brochures, poster, press kit, internet, social media, etc.).

EXHIBITION RIGHTS

The organisation assumes that participants own the rights on the webseries they submit and accepts no responsibility arising from the breach of this rule or any violations that may result from the ownership of the films. When submitting materials for competition, participants agree that they are the owners and are authorised to use full rights of music, video or effects appearing on the webseries. The festival will not be responsible of any claims arising from noncompliance by the creator and/or production company in case they do not own the rights of the materials they submit.
